*The Joy of a 7.1 million  
"something" Christmas Gift!*

If someone whom you loved and trusted offered you a Christmas gift would you take it? My guess is that, like me, you would. What if they then followed up the initial offer by telling you that the gift was going to consist of 7.1 million 'somethings' only to refuse to tell you anything about what those 'somethings' actually were?

At that point, I think I would have to ponder the situation for a bit. After all, a gift of 7.1 million U.S. Dollars or British Pounds or South African diamonds would be fantastic. On the other hand, there are a great many things that others enjoy which I just would not want in such large quantities.

However, if we think for a minute we might realize that we have misunderstood the offer. What if the gift did not consist of material things at all? Further, what if the gift called on you to share something that you already possess and can never lose no matter how often you give it away? Even greater, what if the gift only served to enhance the joy and excitement of what you already possess while costing you nothing? You have to admit, it would be intriguing.

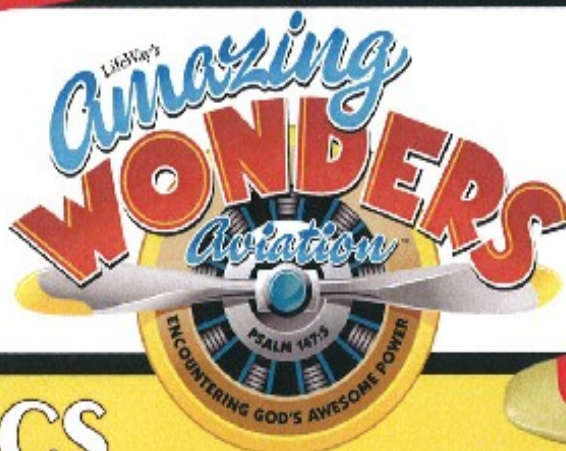
